Reminders

School Closure due to Snow

Should you wake up to snow, we will endeavour to let you know as soon as possible if the school is going to be closed. We notify County, who in turn notify their website, and the local radio stations – Free Radio and Hereford & Worcester. They will announce all school closures in alphabetical order and they also post them on their website. We will also send you a text message – so please ensure that we have your up to-date mobile number and that you have your phone switched on.

May I also remind you that our playground does get very cold as it is so exposed so the children do need to have a warm coat, gloves, hat and scarf in school during this cold weather.

Corona Virus

We are following the guidance of Public Health England on the corona virus. All children will be washing their hands frequently in school including on arrival and departure. The advice is to wash hands for 20 seconds with soap and water. We also have hand sanitiser available in school. Please see the Public Health England website for further information.

Polite request

Could we please ask that you do not send your children into school if they are unwell as we have a chronically ill child in school who is very susceptible to illness. If your child has sickness or diarrhoea they are not to return to school until they have been 48 hours clear. We appreciate your support in this matter as we want to keep all our children and staff fit and well. Thank you.
